

Memorandum of understanding
between
College of Technology and Economics
And
University of Latvia

1. Preamble

In accordance with the principles of mutual benefit and cooperation, the College of Technology and Economics (CTE, legal address: AviatSIONnaya str., 33a, Dnepr, 49000, Ukraine) and the university Latvia (UL, registered address: Raina boulevard 19, Riga, LV 1586, Latvia), hereinafter referred to as the parties, agree to sign the following Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to facilitate closer cooperation between two educational institutions.

2. Areas for Collaboration

Both parties aim to develop educational and scientific co-operation involving all members of their academic communities.

The two institutions will develop and implement student exchange and enhance collaboration in research so as to promote communication between academic staff. These contacts may extend to any appropriate discipline. The exchange of students will be carried out within the limits of financial and other resources of the institutions.

The opportunities for co-operation and mutual intellectual benefit will be greatly enhanced if joint applications can be made to national and international bodies where recourses are provided to facilitate joint programmes of education and research.

Both parties will encourage the development of collaboration initiatives and will provide assistance for seeking financial support from outside sources.

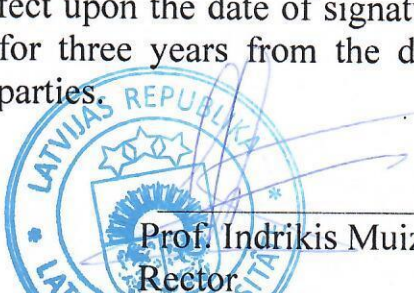
3. Implementation of the MOU

Both parties agree that all financial arrangements necessary for the implementation of this MOU must be negotiated separately and there is the need to hold further discussions on the implementation of Article 2 of this MOU.

Collaborative activities between the two parties that are not covered by the scope of this MOU will be guided by separate agreements between the two parties after detailed discussions and negotiations.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into effect upon the date of signature by the representatives of the two parties. The MOU is valid for three years from the date of singnature and may be renewed by written consent from both parties.
